- Each member must commit to donating \$100 per meeting (\$400 per year).
- The donations will be given to Genesee County area charities/non-profit organizations/worthy causes serving those areas.
- National charities will be considered only if 100% of contributions stay in our community.
- Any member wishing to nominate a local charity/program/nonprofit will place their name in a basket upon arrival at the meeting.
- Three names will be drawn.
- Each of the three members drawn will be given 5 minutes to present information on the charity/program/non-profit she is nominating. There will be an opportunity for members to ask questions.
- If there is an immediate/emergency need at the time of the meeting, that worthy cause can be presented as one of the choices.
- By ballot, the group will vote, with the understanding that the majority rules. Each member agrees to donate to the chosen cause.
- If a member's name is drawn and her charity is not chosen, she will still be eligible to put her name in the drawing at the next meeting.
- Lobbying for a favorite organization prior to the meeting is not allowed.
- The charity/program/non-profit will have to agree **NOT** to use the names of members for future solicitations or give the information out to the public. If the charity does not adhere to this condition they will be removed from any future consideration.
- The meetings will be held at the Captain's Club at Woodfield. Membership to 100 (or more) Women Who Care is open to **ALL** women. The more women we gather, the greater our impact within our community.
